



Dear Carline,

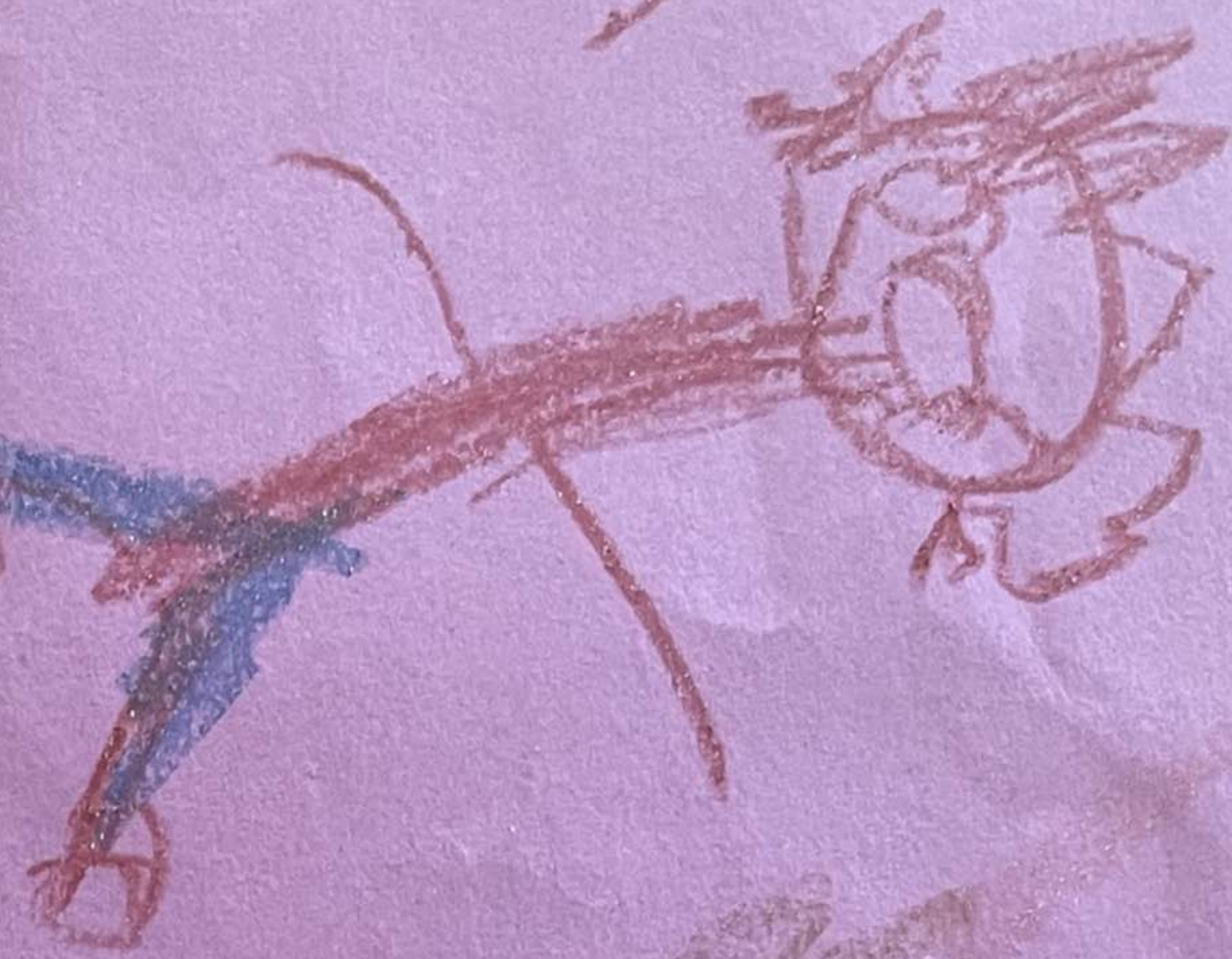

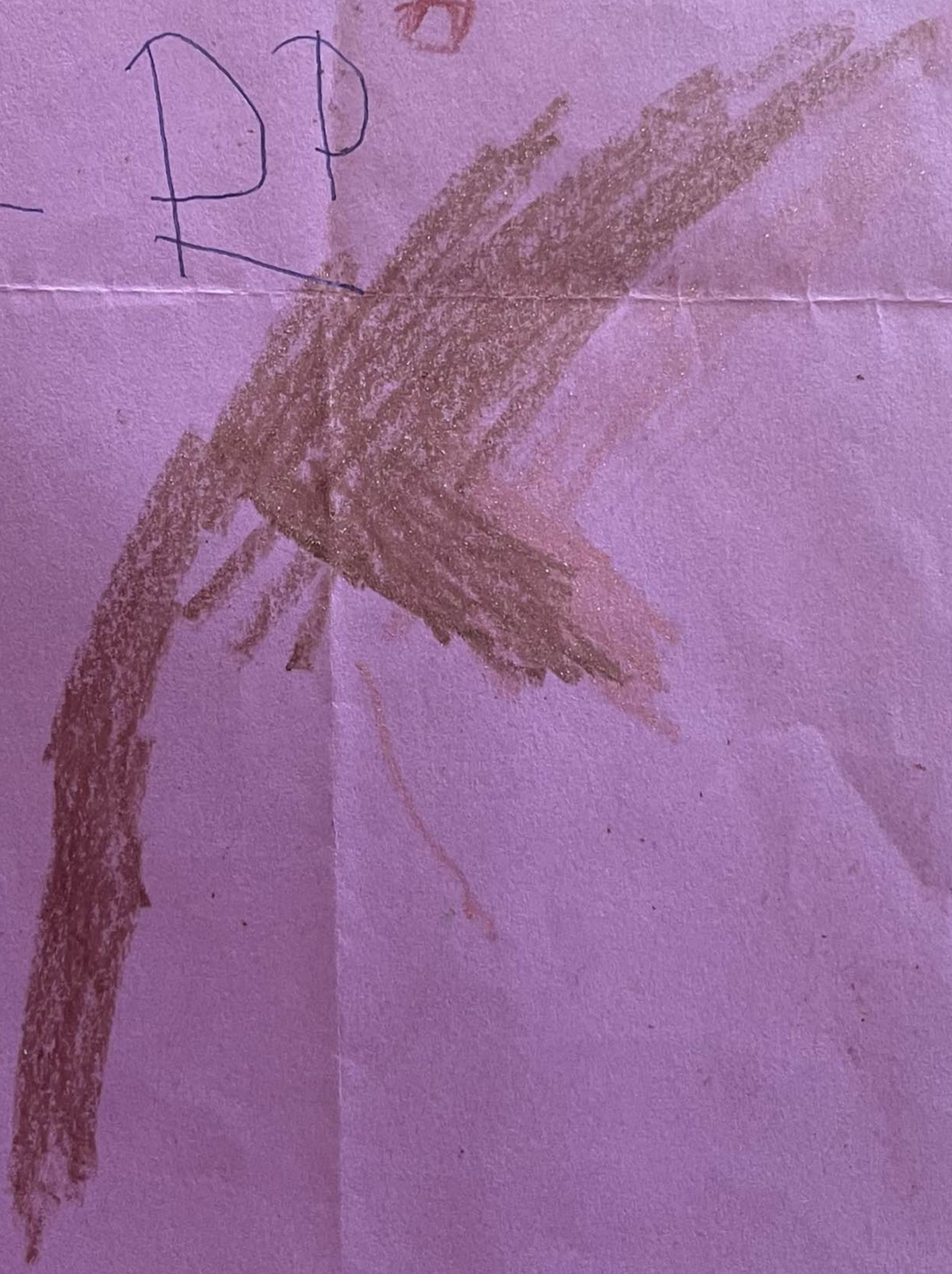
